The Why?

 - ▶ Outings

The How-Planning a Group Connection

- ▶ Goals and Objectives
 - ▶ Why you are providing the meeting
 - ▶ How you are getting the information across
- ▶ Outline your Plan
 - ▶ What are your resources?
- ▶ Develop/Determine Parent Handouts
 - ▶ Original or part of your curriculum
- ▶ Required Forms
 - ▶ DESE Forms
 - ▶ Individual Agency forms
- ▶ Table Partners activity
 - ▶ Generate ideas for planning a group connection

The How-Quality Facilitation

- ▶ Group Involvement
 - ▶ Inclusion activity (a.k.a Icebreakers)
 - ▶ Group activity
 - ▶ Prompts
- ▶ Preventing dominance

The How-Quality Facilitation

- ▶ Addressing Questions
 - ▶ PRER
 - ▶ Begin with your POINT
 - ▶ Give the REASON why it is valid
 - ▶ ELABORATE your reason with example
 - ▶ Close with RESTATEMENT
 - ▶ Want to state another POINT or REASON?
 - ▶ Complete initial thoughts-add second suggestions..."Another point to consider..."

The How-Quality Facilitation

- ▶ Professional Appearances
 - ▶ Handouts
 - ▶ Visual Aids
 - ▶ Personal Movements
 - ▶ Personal Attire
 - ▶ Projection-can you be heard?

The How-Promoting Your Group Connection

- ▶ Communication
 - ▶ Flyers
 - ▶ Family visits
 - ▶ Preschool
 - ▶ Other program components
 - ▶ Facebook
 - ▶ Program Facebook
 - ▶ School District Facebook
